

ISSA RSC 2022 Central Region Election Notice

The ISSA's Review and Selection Committee (RSC) will be holding elections for its Central Region representative at the ISSA Annual Convention in Ames Nov. 11-13.

John Gallentine from the Webster County Ice-Breakers in Region 7 currently serves in that role after filling the unexpired term of John Kahler. Kahler moved to an automatic seat on the committee following his election as ISSA Vice President in 2020.

Since 2017, the RSC has managed 70 percent of the funds generated by snowmobile registration receipts and trail pass fees in Iowa. Meeting twice a year, committee members determine grooming equipment purchases, and eligible snowmobile clubs can apply for grant funding for trail development and maintenance expenses.

Any snowmobiler in Iowa who purchases a snowmobile registration is eligible to serve on the RSC. The representative does not have to be a member of the ISSA or belong to a club. However, the Central Region candidate must reside in ISSA Regions 3, 4, 7 or 8.

The election will be held at noon on Nov. 12 at the Quality Inn and Suites Conference Center in Ames. Committee terms last three years.
